Collection of Personal Information

We may collect personal information in the following ways:

- Information you provide through our website (e.g. in an online application), for an RFA product (e.g. name, email, address etc.). If you communicate with us online or by email, we may collect information contained in that communication, such as your email address or mobile phone number. The security of email communication cannot be guaranteed. If you wish to communicate or send information of a private or confidential nature to RFA, we encourage you to do so by other means.
- Information that your browser sends to us, such as your IP address (a number required for using the Internet that is automatically assigned to your computer or device and from which the general geographic location of the computer or device can be derived).
- Web technologies (e.g. cookies) may be used to collect information about how people use our websites, to enhance security and your user experience, to determine response to emails, or to save personal information that you have inputted into online tools and calculators. Please refer to the documentation for your browser or device regarding how to allow or refuse cookies.

How We Use Your Personal Information

We use the personal information that we collect for the purposes described in our <u>Privacy Policy</u> and <u>Privacy Code</u>, including to:

- Communicate with you
- Provide you with our online products, services and support
- Monitor online activity to protect you and your personal information
- · Enhance online security including preventing and detecting security threats, fraud and other illegal activities

How We Safeguard Your Personal Information

- Firewalls: We have secure firewalls designed to prevent unauthorized access to our systems
- Encryption: All our online financial application forms are encrypted and stored on a secure server in a controlled environment.
